

RESOLUTION NO. 1985- 82

EXTENDING SENIOR CITIZENS' FARE PRIVILEGES FOR THE
NINTH ANNUAL SENIOR CITIZEN COALITION CONVENTION,
APRIL 17, 1985

WHEREAS, The Senior Citizen Coalition will hold their Tenth Annual Convention on Wednesday, April 17, 1985; and

WHEREAS, this event is anticipated to adjourn at about 4:00 p.m.; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees wishes not to impose a cost penalty on Senior citizens attending said convention and utilizing public transportation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority;

Section 1. That between the hours of 4:00 p.m. and 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, April 17, 1985, the reduced 25-cents transit fare shall be extended to all Senior Citizens properly registered with the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority for the reduced Elderly Fare.

Section 2. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
