

RESOLUTION NO. 1985 - 86

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH BUS INDUSTRIES OF AMERICA, INC. FOR THE FURNISHING AND DELIVERING OF THIRTEEN (13) TRANSIT VEHICLES COMPLETELY ACCESSIBLE TO PERSONS HAVING MOBILITY LIMITATIONS AND FOR SPARE PARTS.
(\$1,109,554.00 - Capital Improvement Fund OH-90-0019)

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Bus Industries of America, Inc. received on the 18th day of January, 1985, for the furnishing and delivering of thirteen (13) transit vehicles completely accessible to persons having mobility limitations and for spare parts, at the prices set forth in said bid, involving a total expenditure not to exceed One Million One Hundred Nine Thousand Five Hundred Fifty-Four Dollars (\$1,109,554.00), be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest and best responsible bid, and the General Manager of the Authority is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with said bidder for the furnishing of said item.

Section 2. That said contract shall provide for an expenditure of 80% UMTA funds.

Section 3. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution No. 1981-273; bonding, insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.

Section 5. That said contract shall be subject to UMTA concurrence.
