A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH LANDMARK FORD SALES, INC., FOR THE FURNISHING OF THREE (3) TRANSIT POLICE VEHICLES. (\$39,449.85 - Capital Improvement Fund OH-03-0062)

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Landmark Ford Sales, Inc., received on the 10th day of May, 1985, for the furnishing of three (3) transit police vehicles, at the price set forth in said bid, involving a total expenditure of Thirty-Nine Thousand Four Hundred Forty-Nine & 85/100 (\$39,449.85) Dollars, be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest and best responsible bid, and the General Manager of the Authority is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with said bidder for the furnishing of said item.

Section 2. That said contract shall provide for an expenditure of 80% UMTA funds.
