

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH BROADWAY
WRECKING COMPANY, FOR THE FURNISHING OF KINGSBURY
SHOP DEMOLITION.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland
Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:


Section 1. That the bid of Broadway Wrecking Company received on
the 14th day of May, 1985, for the furnishing of Kingsbury Shop Demolition, at
the price set forth in said bid, involving an estimated expenditure of Twenty
Two Thousand Eight Hundred Twenty & 00/100 (\$22,820.00) Dollars, be and the same
is hereby approved as the lowest and best responsible bid, and the General Manager
of the Authority is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with said bidder
for the furnishing of said item.

Section 2. That said contract shall be payable out of the General
Fund.

Section 3. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obliga-
tion of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid
Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the
Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding, insurance requirements and all
applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately
upon its adoption.
