

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF ROCK SALT  
WITHOUT COMPETITIVE BIDS WITH THE CITY OF CLEVELAND  
(Est. \$25,000.00 - General Fund)

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland  
Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

WHEREAS, Rock Salt is necessary to remove snow and ice from  
various RTA properties during winter 1985-86; and


WHEREAS, it is more economical to purchase this Rock Salt with  
the City of Cleveland than to purchase directly; and


WHEREAS, GCRTA is permitted to enter into a contract with the  
City of Cleveland pursuant to ORC 306.44; the City of Cleveland purchases  
large quantities of Salt through the bid process on the open market; and  
in conformity with the Charter of the City of Cleveland, is permitted to  
sell necessary quantities as requested to GCRTA.

Section 1. That said purchase shall be payable out of the General  
Fund.

Section 2. That this resolution shall become effective immediately  
upon its adoption.
