

RESOLUTION NO. 1985- 260

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH HOLLI-RICH ENTERPRISES;  
FOR THE FURNISHING OF A RAIL ANCHOR MACHINE.  
(\$36,302.00 - Capital Improvement Fund OH-90-0019)

WHEREAS, the bid of Holli-Rich Enterprises, received on the 26th day of July, 1985, to furnish a Rail Anchor Machine, at the price set forth in said bid, involving a total expenditure of Thirty-Six Thousand Three Hundred Two & 00/100 (\$36,302.00) Dollars, be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest and best responsible bid.

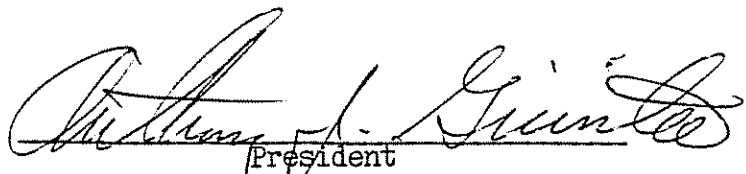
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That said contract shall provide for an expenditure of 80% UMTA funds.

Section 2. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding, insurance requirements, and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 3. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
