A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH SCRANTON TRUCK BODY & EQUIPMENT COMPANY, FOR THE FURNISHING OF THREE (3) TAILGATE SALT SPREADERS.
(\$6,582.00 - Capital Improvement Fund OH-90-0019)

WHEREAS, the bid of Scranton Truck Body & Equipment Company, received on the 8th day of August, 1985, to furnish three (3) Tailgate Salt Spreaders, at the price set forth in said bid, involving a total expenditure of Six Thousand Five Hundred Eighty-Two and 00/100 (\$6,582.00) Dollars, be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest and best responsible bid.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That said contract shall provide for an expenditure of 80% UMTA funds.

Section 2. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution No. 1985-87; bonding, insurance requirements, and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 3. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
