

RESOLUTION NO. 1986 - 48

AUTHORIZING THE GENERAL MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL NECESSARY APPLICATIONS, DOCUMENTS AND INSTRUMENTS TO RECEIVE A GRANT UNDER SECTION 10 OF THE URBAN MASS TRANSPORTATION ACT AND AUTHORIZING AN EXPENDITURE OF \$11,600

WHEREAS, Northeastern University has offered UMTA an opportunity to select transit management personnel for participation in its 39th National Urban Mass Transportation Management Seminar; and

WHEREAS, UMTA has selected Timothy Walton, Jr., Equipment Engineer and Eugene Attinoto, Superintendent of Traffic for participation in the program; and

WHEREAS, UMTA will pay \$6,500 of the \$13,000 total cost; and

WHEREAS, in order to permit Messrs. Walton's and Attinoto's participation, the General Manager must execute certain applications and an expenditure of \$11,600 to cover university expenses must be authorized. FURTHER, that this \$11,600 is included in the total cost, of which UMTA will reimburse \$6,500 and the Authority will pay \$6,500.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga, County, Ohio;


Section 1. That the General Manager of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority is hereby authorized to execute a Grant under Section 10 of the Urban Mass Transportation Act for the participation of Timothy Walton, Jr. and Eugene Attinoto in the 39th National Urban Mass Transportation Management Seminar which is offered by Northeastern University, March 31 to April 10, 1986 and August 11 to August 21, 1986.

Section 2. That the Director of Finance be and is hereby authorized to pay Northeastern University the amount of \$11,600 payable out of the General Fund.

Section 3. That this Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its adoption.
