

RESOLUTION NO. 1986-65

A RESOLUTION REJECTING THE BID OF JERRY J. VENCL FOR THE SALE OF UNUSED BUS PARTS, AND AWARDING THE SALE OF CERTAIN ITEMS TO KENT STATE UNIVERSITY

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 1985-209 adopted by the Board of Trustees on August 20, 1985, the Director of Procurement was authorized to seek competitive bids for the sale of unused and used transit equipment no longer required, and advertised two (2) times, receiving no bids the first time; and

WHEREAS, in response to said second competitive bidding solicitation, two (2) bids were received for unused bus parts; and

WHEREAS, the bid of Kent State University is \$217.00, for various bus air conditioning parts; and

WHEREAS, this bid is judged to be fair and equitable to the Authority; and

WHEREAS, Jerry J. Vencl's bid was \$469.00 for all parts; and

WHEREAS, this bid was deemed to be too low; and

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio;

Section 1. That the bid of Kent State University for \$217.00 be accepted and the General Manager be authorized to enter into a contract for these items bid upon by Kent State University.


Section 2. That the bid of Jerry J. Vencl's \$469.00 be rejected.

Section 3. That the Procurement Department be and is hereby authorized to rebid all of the remaining property.

Section 4. The proceeds of the sale of these parts shall be deposited into the General Fund.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
