

RESOLUTION NO. 1986-98

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITHOUT COMPETITIVE BIDDING WITH GENERAL MOTORS CORPORATION FOR THE FURNISHING OF REPAIR PARTS, FOR A PERIOD OF ONE (1) YEAR.
(\$650,000.00 - General Fund)

WHEREAS, these repair parts are manufactured only by General Motors Corporation and cannot be secured from any source other than General Motors Corporation; and

WHEREAS, a contract expired on October 31, 1985, in the amount of Six Hundred Fifty Thousand and 00/100 (\$650,000.00) Dollars; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio revised Code 306.43(b) provides that competition is not required for replacement parts of Transit Authority equipment if the only source is from single suppliers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That it is hereby determined that the within commodities are non-competitive and cannot be secured from any source other than General Motors Corporation.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the General Motors Corporation for the furnishing of repair parts for the General Motors Corporation coaches, for a period of one (1) year, involving a total expenditure of Six Hundred Fifty Thousand and 00/100 (\$650,000.00) Dollars.

Section 3. That the purchase orders issued by the Department of Procurement shall be in accordance with the Parts Price List and terms on file.

Section 4. That the contract shall be subject to the non-discrimination clause.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
