AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH HARRIS BATTERY MANUFACTURING COMPANY FOR THE FURNISHING OF BUS BATTERIES (TYPE 31), FOR A PERIOD OF ONE (1) YEAR (Est. \$59,570.00 - General Fund)

That the bid of Harris Battery Manufacturing Company to furnish bus batteries (Type 31), for a period of one (1) year involving an estimated total expenditure of Fifty-Nine Thousand Five Hundred Seventy and 00/100 (\$59,570.00) Dollars be and it is hereby approved as the lowest and best bid.
