

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH D. A. CENTRAL, INC., FOR THE FURNISHING AND INSTALLING OF A CLOSED CIRCUIT SURVEILLANCE SYSTEM IN THE REVENUE BUILDING. (\$21,507.00 - General Fund)

WHEREAS, the Revenue Building is completed and is in need of a Closed Circuit Surveillance System; and

WHEREAS, bids were received from five (5) companies; and

WHEREAS, the bid received from D. A. Central, Inc. received on the 11th day of March, 1986 for the Installation of A Closed Circuit Surveillance System in the Revenue Building was the lowest and best responsible bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:


Section 1. That the bid of D. A. Central, Inc., received on the 11th day of March, 1986, for the furnishing and installing of a Closed Circuit Surveillance System in the Revenue Building, at the price set forth in said bid, involving a total expenditure of Twenty-One Thousand Five Hundred Seven & 00/100 (\$21,507.00) Dollars, be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest and best responsible bid, and the General Manager of the Authority is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with said bidder for the furnishing of the said item.


Section 2. That this contract shall be payable out of the General Fund.

Section 3. That said contract shall be binding upon an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding, insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon
