

RESOLUTION NO. 1986- 146

AUTHORIZING THE GENERAL MANAGER TO PROVIDE EXPERIMENTAL SERVICES FOR A PERIOD NOT MORE THAN THREE MONTHS AND AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF PROCUREMENT TO ADVERTISE FOR COMPETITIVE BIDS FOR THE POSSIBLE CONTINUATION OF SAID TRANSPORTATION SERVICES

WHEREAS, The Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority desires to enhance public confidence by providing the best possible public transportation service to the people of Cuyahoga County; and

WHEREAS, the Authority wishes to contribute to the economic development of Cuyahoga County; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has received a request to provide public transportation services to employees in the Mercantile Road area of Beachwood, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the provision of such experimental service on an experimental basis would be an innovative service improvement consistent with federal initiatives on private enterprise participation; and

WHEREAS, the seeking of competitive bids would enable the Authority to determine the responsiveness of transportation providers to such transportation options; and

WHEREAS, the Authority would be able to market the provision of such service to companies and industrial parks throughout Cuyahoga County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County:


Section 1. That the General Manager is hereby authorized to provide experimental service from Mercantile Road in Beachwood, Ohio to certain designated locations to be designated within Cuyahoga County.

Section 2. That said service shall be provided for a period not to exceed three calendar months.


Section 3. That the Department of Procurement be and is hereby authorized to advertise for competitive bids for the possible provision of supplemental transportation services.

Section 4. That this resolution shall be and is hereby effective immediately upon its adoption.
