AUTHORIZING THE GENERAL MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH AMERICAN MERCHANDISING SERVICES, FOR THE FURNISHING OF UNLEADED GASOLINE, FOR A PERIOD OF ONE (1) YEAR. (Est. \$138,000.00 - General Fund)

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of American Merchandising Services, received on the 21st day of April, 1986, for the furnishing of Unleaded Gasoline, for a period of one (1) year, at the price set forth in said bid, involving an estimated expenditure of One Hundred Thirty-Eight Thousand (\$138,000.00) Dollars, be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest and best responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with American Merchandising Services, for the furnishing of Unleaded Gasoline.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Fund.

That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding, insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
