

RESOLUTION NO. 1986 - 168

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH G & G EXTERMINATING COMPANY, FOR THE CLEANING OF COMFORT STATIONS FOR A PERIOD OF THREE (3) YEARS. (Est. \$36,680.64 - General Fund)

WHEREAS, the bid of G & G Exterminating Company for the Cleaning of Comfort Stations was received on the 23rd day of April, 1986, for the price set forth in said bid, involving an estimated expenditure of Thirty-Six Thousand, Six Hundred Eighty and 64/100 (\$36,680.64) Dollars;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of G & G Exterminating, for the Cleaning of Comfort Stations, for a period of three (3) years, involving an estimated expenditure of Thirty-Six Thousand, Six Hundred Eighty & 64/100 (\$36,680.64) Dollars, be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.


Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with G & G Exterminating Company, for the Cleaning of Comfort Stations.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Fund.

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
