

RESOLUTION NO. 1986 - 185

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH CLEVELAND CHEMICAL PEST CONTROL FOR THE FURNISHING OF WEED KILLING, RAPID TRANSIT RIGHT OF WAY, FOR A PERIOD OF THREE (3) YEARS.
(Est. \$68,964.00 - General Fund)

WHEREAS, the bid of Cleveland Chemical Pest Control for the furnishing of Weed Killing, Rapid Transit Right of Way was received on the 26th day of March, 1986, for the price set forth in said bid, involving an estimated expenditure of Sixty-Eight Thousand, Nine Hundred Sixty-Four & 00/100 (\$68,964.00) Dollars;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Cleveland Chemical Pest Control, received on the 26th day of March, 1986, for furnishing of Weed Killing, Rapid Transit Right of Way for a period of three years, at the price set forth in said bid, involving an estimated expenditure of Sixty-Eight Thousand, Nine Hundred Sixty-Four & 00/100 (\$68,964.00) Dollars, be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Cleveland Chemical Pest Control, for the furnishing of Weed Killing, Rapid Transit Right of Way.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Fund.

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
