

RESOLUTION NO. 1986 - 202

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH GREAT LAKES ENERGY SYSTEMS,  
FOR THE FURNISHING OF REBUILT DIESEL FUEL INJECTORS,  
FOR A PERIOD OF ONE (1) YEAR.  
(Est. \$21,718.00 - General Fund)

WHEREAS, the bid of the Great Lakes Energy Systems for the furnishing of Rebuilt Diesel Fuel Injectors was received on the 6th day of May, 1986, for the price set forth in said bid, involving an estimated expenditure of Twenty-One Thousand, Seven Hundred Eighteen & 00/100 (\$21,718.00) Dollars;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Great Lakes Energy Systems received on the 6th day of May, 1986, for the furnishing of Rebuilt Diesel Fuel Injectors for one (1) year, at the price set forth in said bid, involving an estimated expenditure of Twenty-One Thousand, Seven Hundred Eighteen & 00/100 (\$21,718.00) Dollars, be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the Great Lakes Energy Systems, for the furnishing of Rebuilt Diesel Fuel Injectors.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Fund.

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
