## RESOLUTION NO. 1986 - 254

RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 1986-168, WHICH AWARDED A CONTRACT TO G & G EXTERMINATING COMPANY, FOR THE CLEANING OF COMFORT STATIONS AND AWARDING THIS CONTRACT TO LECAP BUILDING SERVICES, FOR A PERIOD OF THREE (3) YEARS.

(Est. \$45,097.44 - General Fund)

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority awarded a contract to G & G Exterminating Company per Resolution No. 1986-168 which was adopted June 3, 1986; and

WHEREAS, this contract has not been executed; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that G & G Exterminating Company has failed to secure a Performance Bond and is therefore non-responsible.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That Resolution No. 1986-168 be rescinded.

Section 2. That the bid of LeCap Building Services, received on the 23rd day of April, 1986, for the cleaning of comfort stations for a period of three (3) years, at the price set forth in said bid, involving an estimated expenditure of Forty-Five Thousand, Ninety-Seven & 44/100 (\$45,097.44) Dollars, be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 3. That the General Manager of the Authority be and is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with LeCap Building Services, for the cleaning of comfort stations.

Section 4. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Fund.

Section 5. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 6. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
