

RESOLUTION NO. 1986 - 283

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH COOK PAVING AND CONSTRUCTION CO. FOR THE REHABILITATION OF PARKING LOTS: TRISKETT, W. 117TH-MADISON, AND WEST 98TH (PROJECT 1.69 - \$115,520.00 - General Fund)

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Cook Paving and Construction Company received on the 12th day of September, 1986, for the rehabilitation of the parking lots at the Triskett, W. 117th-Madison, and W. 98th stations at the price set forth in said bid, involving a total estimated expenditure of One Hundred Fifteen Thousand Five Hundred Twenty and 00/100 (\$115,520.00) Dollars be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest and best responsive bid from a responsible bidder, and the General Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with said bidder for said work.

Section 2. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Fund.

Section 3. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding, insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 4. That this Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its adoption.
