

RESOLUTION NO. 1986 - 294

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH TURNER EQUIPMENT, INC.,
FOR THE FURNISHING OF ONE (1) PAPER CUTTER, ONE (1)
PRINTING PRESS, ONE (1) VERTICAL CAMERA AND ONE (1)
PAPER FOLDER.
(\$126,106.00 - Capital Improvement Fund OH-03-0062)

WHEREAS, the bid of Turner Equipment, Inc., to furnish one (1)
Paper Cutter, one (1) Printing Press, one (1) Vertical Camera and one (1)
Paper Folder was received on the 18th day of August, 1986, for the price
set forth in said bid, involving a total expenditure of One Hundred
Twenty-Six Thousand, One Hundred Six & 00/100 (\$126,106.00) Dollars;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the
Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Turner Equipment, Inc., for one
(1) Paper Cutter, one (1) Printing Press, one (1) Vertical Camera and one
(1) Paper Folder involving a total expenditure of One Hundred Twenty-Six
Thousand, One Hundred Six & 00/100 (\$126,106.00) Dollars be and it is
hereby approved as the lowest responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and
is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Turner Equipment,
Inc., for one (1) Paper Cutter, one (1) Printing Press, one (1) Vertical
Camera and one (1) Paper Folder.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the
Capital Improvement Fund OH-03-0062.

Section 4. That portion of the contract attributable to the
Paper cutter and Printing Press are subject to UMTA approval.

Section 5. That said contract shall be binding upon and an
obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor
to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan
adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding, insurance
requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations
of the Authority.

Section 6. That this resolution shall become effective
immediately upon its adoption.
