

RESOLUTION NO. 1987-46

ESTABLISHING THE REQUIREMENTS FOR SUBMISSION TO
URBAN MASS TRANSPORTATION ADMINISTRATION FOR
REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF CONTRACTS LET BY THE
GREATER CLEVELAND REGIONAL TRANSIT AUTHORITY
FOR AMOUNTS OF MORE THAN \$10,000.00

WHEREAS, the Urban Mass Transportation Administration (UMTA) has determined that the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority (GCRTA) must submit for review all UMTA-funded contracts of more than \$10,000, including operating assistance contracts; and


WHEREAS, the GCRTA desires to cooperate with the Urban Mass Transportation Administration in the administration of procurement procedures.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That all contracts of more than \$10,000, including operating assistance contracts be and they shall be submitted to UMTA for approval and such approval shall be a condition precedent to the Authority entering into said contracts.

Section 2. That this Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its adoption.
