## RESOLUTION NO. 1987-47

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITHOUT COMPETITIVE BIDDING WITH GENERAL RAILWAY SIGNAL COMPANY FOR THE FURNISHING OF SIGNAL SYSTEM REPAIR AND REPLACEMENT PARTS FOR A PERIOD OF TWO (2) YEARS (\$90,000.00 - General Fund)

WHEREAS, the Authority requires repair and replacement parts for the Signal System, such as Printed Circuit Boards for Signal System Control, internal parts for Switch Machines, Train Stops and related parts and Integrated Circuit Chips; and

WHEREAS, the Printed Circuit Boards and Integrated Circuit Chips are proprietary and non-competitive; and

WHEREAS, the internal parts for the Switch Machines, Train Stops and related parts are non-competitive and cannot be secured from any source other than General Railway Signal Company; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code 306.43(B) provides that competitive bidding is not required for services if the only source is from a single supplier;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That it is hereby determined that the within commodities are non-competitive and cannot be secured from any source other than the General Railway Signal Company.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the General Railway Signal Company for the furnishing of Signal System Spare Parts for a period of two (2) years, involving an estimated expenditure of Ninety Thousand and 00/100 (\$90,000.00) Dollars.

Section 3. That the purchase orders issued by the Department of Procurement shall be in accordance with the Price List and Terms on file.

Section 4. That the contract shall be subject to the non-discrimination clause.
