WHEREAS, the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority is the designated recipient for federal funds allocated to the Cleveland Urbanized Area and, as such, is the applicant for and recipient of both federal and state funds on behalf of Laketran; and

WHEREAS, the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority has applied to the Urban Mass Transportation Administration and the Ohio Department of Transportation for 1987 funds on behalf of Laketran, pursuant to Resolutions 1987-11 and 1987-12.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority:

Section 1. That the General Manager of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority is authorized to pass-through the 1987 Urban Mass Transportation funds received on behalf of Laketran (\$692,800 capital and \$418,494 operating).

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority is authorized to pass-through the 1987 Ohio Department of Transportation funds received on behalf of Laketran (\$86,600 capital and \$125,548 operating) to Laketran.

Section 3. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
