

RESOLUTION NO. 1987 - 58

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH GEORGE ALLEN CONSTRUCTION COMPANY FOR THE FURNISHING OF PROJECT 1.74, UNDERGROUND OIL STORAGE TANK REPLACEMENT, TRISKETT GARAGE.
(Est. \$44,530.00 - General Fund)

WHEREAS, the bid of George Allen Construction Company, for the furnishing of Underground Oil Storage Tank Replacement, Triskett, was received on the 23rd day of January, 1987, for the price set forth in said bid, involving an estimated expenditure of Forty-Four Thousand, Five Hundred Thirty & 00/100 (\$44,530.00) Dollars;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of George Allen Construction Company, received on the 23rd day of January, 1987, for the furnishing of Underground Oil Storage Tank Replacement, Triskett, at the price set forth in said bid, involving an estimated expenditure of Forty-Four Thousand, Five Hundred Thirty & 00/100 (\$44,530.00) Dollars, be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest and best responsive bid from a responsible bidder.


Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with George Allen Construction Company, for the furnishing of Underground Oil Storage Tank Replacement, Triskett.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Fund.

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon UMTA concurrence.
