NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Northside Motors, Inc., received on the 9th day of March, 1987, for the sale of twenty-five (25) non-operable coaches, at the price set forth in said bid, involving a total sale price of Two Thousand, Eight Hundred Sixty-Two & 50/100 (\$2,862.50) Dollars be and the same is hereby approved as the highest responsive bid from a responsible bidder based on the highest unit price.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Northside Motors, Inc., for the sale of twenty-five (25) non-operable coaches.

Section 3. That Two Thousand, Four Hundred Sixteen & 50/100 (\$2,416.50) Dollars will be deposited in the Capital Improvement Funds indicated above and Four Hundred Forty-Six & 00/100 (\$446.00) Dollars will be deposited into the General Fund.

Section 4. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
