EXPRESSING APPRECIATION TO HARRY ALEXANDER FOR
HIS SERVICE AS A MEMBER OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES
OF THE GREATER CLEVELAND REGIONAL TRANSIT AUTHORITY

WHEREAS, Harry Alexander served as a member of the Board of Trustees for twelve years, having been appointed to the original Board on March 3, 1975, as a representative of the City of Cleveland; and

WHEREAS, Harry Alexander provided the Board of Trustees with his depth of experience as business manager of the leading minority newspaper in the State of Ohio, as a long-time volunteer on the political scene, both locally and nationally, and in recent years as the only remaining original member of the Board; and

WHEREAS, Harry Alexander carefully considered the transit needs of his constituents, particularly those persons dependent on transit services; and

WHEREAS, Harry Alexander served continuously as either President or Vice President of the Board of Trustees from March 8, 1977, until his retirement from the Board; and

WHEREAS, Harry Alexander has served at various times on nine standing committees and task forces of the Board of Trustees and has been Chairman of the Finance Committee, the Merit System Appeals Board, and the Marketing & Communications Committee; and

WHEREAS, Harry Alexander has faithfully performed his duties as a member of this Board with perseverance and courtesy;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the most sincere appreciation of the Board of Trustees is hereby extended to Harry Alexander for his long and dedicated service to the Authority on behalf of the riding public and the citizens of Cuyahoga County.

Section 2. That the members of the Board of Trustees express their gratitude to Harry Alexander for his diligence in the performance of his responsibilities and for his sensitivity to the transit needs of all residents of Cuyahoga County.


