

RESOLUTION NO. 1987-104

AUTHORIZING AN INTER-AGENCY AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE
NORTHEAST OHIO AREAWIDE COORDINATING AGENCY AND THE
GREATER CLEVELAND REGIONAL TRANSIT AUTHORITY TO
PROVIDE ADDITIONAL RIDERSHIP DATA AND
RESOURCES FOR DUAL HUB CORRIDOR ALTERNATIVES
ANALYSTS DEMAND MODELING VALIDATION

WHEREAS, the Northeast Ohio Areawide Coordinating Agency (NOACA) is the Metropolitan Planning Organization for the Counties of Cuyahoga, Lake, Geauga, Medina and Lorain pursuant to the designation by the Governor of the State of Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority (GCRTA) is a publicly owned operator of mass transportation services as that term is defined in Department of Transportation Regulations; and

WHEREAS, the GCRTA has prime responsibilities for preparations of the public mass transit portion of the Transportation System Management Element and Transportation Improvement Program in Cuyahoga County; and

WHEREAS, GCRTA has agreed to provide assistance, at a cost not to exceed \$9,500, to NOACA in completing the coding and analysis of data to conduct or manage the Transportation System Management Element and Transportation Improvement Program efforts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the General Manager be and he is hereby authorized to execute an inter-agency agreement with NOACA for the purpose of providing supplemental ridership data and dollar resources in order to fulfill the requirements of the public mass transit portion of the Transportation System Management Element and Transportation Improvement Program in Cuyahoga County.

Section 2. That said agreement shall provide that GCRTA will provide to NOACA an amount not to exceed \$9,500.

Section 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
