

RESOLUTION NO. 1987-113

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH CLEVELAND TECHNICAL CENTER FOR THE FURNISHING OF ENGINE OIL ANALYSIS FOR A PERIOD OF TWO (2) YEARS.  
(Est. \$133,947.00 - General Fund)

WHEREAS, the bid of Cleveland Technical Center, for the furnishing of Engine Oil Analysis was received on the 23rd day of February, 1987, for the price set forth in said bid, involving an estimated expenditure of One Hundred Thirty-Three Thousand, Nine Hundred Forty-Seven & 00/100 (\$133,947.00) Dollars;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Cleveland Technical Center, received on the 23rd day of February, 1987, for the furnishing of Engine Oil Analysis for two (2) years, at the price set forth in said bid, involving an estimated expenditure of One Hundred Thirty-Three Thousand, Nine Hundred Forty-Seven & 00/100 (\$133,947.00) Dollars, be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest and best responsive bid from a responsible bidder based on the lowest unit price.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Cleveland Technical Center, for the furnishing of Engine Oil Analysis.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Fund.

Section 4. That said contract is subject to UMTA approval.

Section 5. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 6. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
