

RESOLUTION NO. 1987- 141

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH UNIVERSAL OIL, INCORPORATED
FOR THE FURNISHING OF TRANSMISSION FLUID FOR A PERIOD
OF ONE (1) YEAR.
(EST. \$49,500.00 - GENERAL FUND)

WHEREAS, the bid of Universal Oil, Incorporated, for the
furnishing of Transmission Fluid was received on the 23rd day of April,
1987, for the price set forth in said bid, involving an estimated
expenditure of Forty-Nine Thousand Five Hundred & 00/100 (\$49,500.00)
Dollars;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the
Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Universal Oil, Incorporated, for
the furnishing of Transmission Fluid received on the 23rd day of April,
1987, for one (1) year, at the price set forth in said bid, involving an
estimated expenditure of Forty-Nine Thousand Five Hundred & 00/100
(\$49,500.00) Dollars, be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest
and best responsive bid from a responsible bidder based on the lowest
unit price.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he
is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Universal Oil,
Incorporated, for the furnishing of Transmission Fluid.


Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the
General Fund.

Section 4. That said contract is subject to UMTA approval.

Section 5. That said contract shall be binding upon and an
obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor
to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan
adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding insurance
requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations
of the Authority.

Section 6. That this resolution shall become effective
immediately upon its adoption.
