

RESOLUTION NO. 1987- 154

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH HARRIS BATTERY COMPANY  
FOR THE FURNISHING OF TYPE 8-D BUS BATTERIES FOR A  
PERIOD OF ONE (1) YEAR.  
(Est. \$25,875.00 - General Fund)

WHEREAS, the bid of Harris Battery Company, for the furnishing of Type 8-D Bus Batteries was received on the 16th day of March, 1987, involving an estimated expenditure of Twenty-Five Thousand, Eight Hundred Seventy-Five & 00/100 (\$25,875.00) Dollars;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Harris Battery Company, received on the 16th day of March, 1987, for the furnishing of Type 8-D Bus Batteries for one (1) year, at the price set forth in said bid, involving an estimated expenditure of Twenty-Five Thousand, Eight Hundred Seventy-Five & 00/100 (\$25,875.00) Dollars, be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest and best responsive bid from a responsible bidder based on the lowest unit price.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Harris Battery Company, for the furnishing of Type 8-D Bus Batteries.


Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Fund.


Section 4. That said contract is subject to UMTA approval.

Section 5. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 6. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
