## RESOLUTION NO. 1987-185

EXTENDING SENIOR CITIZENS' FARE PRIVILEGES ON NEOTA DAY, OCTOBER 9, 1987

WHEREAS, on October 9, 1987, NEOTA day, there will be extensive programs involving the Cleveland Zoo and the Cuyahoga County Library; and

WHEREAS, many students and their families, including senior citizens, will attend the Cleveland Zoo on that day; and

WHEREAS, an extension of senior citizens' fare privileges on October 9, 1987, will enhance public participation in these educational programs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That between the hours of 4:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. on Friday, October 9, 1987, the reduced 25-cents transit fare shall be extended to all senior citizens properly registered with the GCRTA for the reduced Elderly Fare.

Section 2. That this resolution shall be effective immediately upon its adoption.
