REJECTING PROPOSALS FOR THE FURNISHING OF ARCHITECT/ ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE REHABILITATION OF TRISKETT AND HAYDEN BUS GARAGES

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 1983-233, adopted September 20, 1983 provided notification for the need for professional services and the submission of proposals for the Architect/Engineering services required for various projects of Capital Grant OH-90-0001; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that Resolution, a Request for Proposals was issued on November 15, 1984; and

WHEREAS, proposals were received from five (5) companies for the furnishing of Architect/Engineering services on January 7, 1985; and

WHEREAS, the proposals received from Robert P. Madsion, International and by DeLeuw, Cather/Polytech, a joint venture, were determined to be the best and most qualified; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 1985-137 authorized the General Manager to negotiate two (2) separate contracts for Architect/Engineering services as required to implement Capital Grant OH-90-0001 (Project 17, Rehabilitation of Four Bus Garages); and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 1986-274 authorized the General Manager to enter into a contract with Robert P. Madison, International to furnish Architect/Engineering services for the rehabilitation of Brooklyn and Woodhill bus garages, Project 17; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined to be in the best interest of the Authority to prioritize the bus garage rehabilitation with the construction to start at Hayden sometime in late 1990; and

WHEREAS, too much elapsed time between the completion of the design work and start of construction is not beneficial to the Authority;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the portion of the proposals for the furnishing of Architect/Engineering services that relate to the rehabilitation of Triskett and Hayden bus garages received on January 7, 1985, be and the same is hereby rejected. RESOLUTION NO. 1987-208 Page 2

Section 2. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
