

RESOLUTION NO. 1987-236

AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF ROCK SALT WITHOUT
COMPETITIVE BIDS FROM THE CITY OF CLEVELAND
(EST. \$30,000.00 - GENERAL FUND) FACILITIES
MAINTENANCE BUDGET.

WHEREAS, Rock Salt is necessary to remove snow and ice from various Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority properties during the winter of 1987-88; and

WHEREAS, it is more economical to purchase this Rock Salt from the City of Cleveland than to purchase directly; and

WHEREAS, the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority is permitted to enter into a contract with the City of Cleveland pursuant to Ohio Revised Code 306.44. The City of Cleveland purchases large quantities of Salt through the bid process and in conformity with the Charter of the City of Cleveland, it is permitted to sell necessary quantities of Rock Salt as requested to the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the purchase of Rock Salt from the City of Cleveland at a cost of Nineteen & 15/100 (\$19.15) Dollars per ton be and it is hereby authorized.

Section 2. That said purchase shall be payable out of the General Fund and the expenditure shall not exceed Thirty Thousand & 00/100 (\$30,000.00) Dollars.

Section 3. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
