

RESOLUTION NO. 1987- 241

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH THE GLOBE GLASS AND MIRROR COMPANY FOR THE FURNISHING OF TEMPERED GLASS FOR A PERIOD OF TWO (2) YEARS.  
(EST. \$126,384.00 - GENERAL FUND) PLANT DEPARTMENT BUDGET

WHEREAS, the bid of the Globe Glass and Mirror Company, for the furnishing of Tempered Glass was received on the 26th day of May, 1987, for the price set forth in said bid, involving an estimated expenditure of One Hundred Twenty-Six Thousand, Three Hundred Eighty-Four & 00/100 (\$126,384.00) Dollars;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of the Globe Glass and Mirror Company, for the furnishing of Tempered Glass be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest and best responsible bid from a responsible bidder based on the lowest unit price.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the Globe Glass and Mirror Company.


Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Fund and provide for the expenditure of One Hundred Twenty-Six Thousand, Three Hundred Eighty-Four & 00/100 (\$126,384.00) Dollars.


Section 4. That said contract is subject to UMTA approval.

Section 5. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 6. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
