Section 1. That the bid of Penn Machine Company, received on the 19th day of December, 1986, for the furnishing of Replaceable Steel Tires and Rubber Pads, L.R.V., for one (1) year, at the price set forth in said bid, involving an estimated expenditure of Two Hundred Twenty-Two Thousand & 00/100 (\$222,000.00) Dollars at a unit cost of Eight Hundred Eight-Eight & 00/100 (\$888.00), be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest and best responsive bid from a responsible bidder based on the lowest unit price.

Section 2. That the General Manager or the Acting General Manager be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Penn Machine Company, for the furnishing of Replaceable Steel Tires and Rubber Pads, L.R.V.
