

RESOLUTION NO. 1987- 250

AUTHORIZING CHANGE ORDER 17-P1, PROJECT 17, ARCHITECTURAL/
ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR REHABILITATION OF BROOKLYN AND
WOODHILL BUS GARAGES.
(\$12,421.60 - CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT GRANT OH-05-0025)

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has, by Resolution No. 1986-274
authorized the General Manager to execute a contract with Robert P. Madison
International; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that Environmental Protection
Agency regulations require that underground fuel tanks be tested to determine
that said tanks meet environmental safety standards; and

WHEREAS, the scope of said testing is not included in the Robert
P. Madison International contract; and

WHEREAS, it has been recommended that this Change Order be approved
to allow work to progress:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the
Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the General Manager be and he is authorized to
execute the following Change Order:

Testing of underground diesel fuel tanks at the Brooklyn
and Woodhill Bus Garages to determine compliance with the
Environmental Protection Agency.


The cost of this Change Order is Twelve Thousand, Four
Hundred Twenty-One & 60/100 (\$12,421.60).

Section 2. That said Change Order shall be payable out of Capital
Improvement Grant OH-05-0025.

Section 3. That said Change Order is subject to UMTA approval.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately
upon its adoption.
