

AUTHORIZING THE GENERAL MANAGER TO PASS-THROUGH URBAN MASS
TRANSPORTATION ADMINISTRATION AND OHIO DEPARTMENT OF
TRANSPORTATION FUNDS TO BRUNSWICK DURING 1988

WHEREAS, the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority is the designated recipient for federal funds allocated to the Cleveland Urbanized Area and, as such, is the applicant for and recipient of both federal and state funds on behalf of Brunswick; and

WHEREAS, the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority has applied to the Urban Mass Transportation Administration and the Ohio Department of Transportation for 1988 funds on behalf of Brunswick, pursuant to Resolution No. 1987-262.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority:

Section 1. That the General Manager of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority is authorized to pass-through the 1988 Urban Mass Transportation funds received on behalf of Brunswick (\$49,350 operating).

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority is authorized to pass-through the 1988 Ohio Department of Transportation funds received on behalf of Brunswick (\$24,579 operating).

Section 3. That this resolution shall be effective immediately upon its adoption.
