

RESOLUTION NO. 1987- 267

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH THE GEORGE WORTHINGTON COMPANY FOR THE FURNISHING OF SEMAPHORE LAMPS FOR A PERIOD OF ONE (1) YEAR (EST. \$20,671.60 - GENERAL FUND) - INVENTORY DEPARTMENT BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the bid of The George Worthington Company, for the furnishing of Semaphore Lamps was received on the 17th day of August, 1987, for the price set forth in said bid, involving an estimated expenditure of Twenty Thousand Six Hundred Seventy-One & 60/100 (\$20,671.60) Dollars;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of The George Worthington Company, for the furnishing of Semaphore Lamps be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest and best responsive bid from a responsible bidder based on the lowest unit price.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with The George Worthington Company, for the furnishing of Semaphore Lamps.


Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Fund in an estimated amount of Twenty Thousand Six Hundred Seventy-One & 60/100 (\$20,671.60) Dollars.

Section 4. That said contract is subject to UMTA approval.

Section 5. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 6. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
