

RESOLUTION 1988-68

AUTHORIZING A TWO (2) YEAR CONTRACT WITH WELLS FARGO GUARD SERVICE TO PROVIDE PROFESSIONAL SECURITY SERVICES AT VARIOUS GCRTA LOCATIONS (EST. COST \$403,989.00 - GENERAL FUND) OPERATION DEPARTMENT BUDGET

WHEREAS, proposals were received on September 11, 1987 to provide Professional Security Services at various Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority locations for a two (2) year period, and

WHEREAS, the proposals were properly evaluated in accordance with the criteria set forth in the request for proposals, and Part 15 of the FAR; and

WHEREAS, the proposal submitted by Wells Fargo Guard Service was determined to be the best and most responsive to the needs of the Authority;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the proposal submitted by Wells Fargo Guard Services be and it is hereby approved as the best and most responsive proposal for the furnishing of Professional Security Services at various Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority locations.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a two (2) year contract with Wells Fargo Guard Services to provide Professional Security Service at an estimated cost of Four Hundred Three Thousand Nine Hundred Eighty nine & 00/100 (\$403,989.00) dollars.

Section 3. That said contract shall incorporate and be consistent with the proposal of Wells Fargo Guard Services and the RFP issued on June 25, 1987 and the Authority's general terms and conditions.

Section 4. That said contract shall be payable from the General Fund.

Section 5. That said contract is subject to UMTA approval.

Section 6. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor with the Proposed Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 7. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
