

RESOLUTION 1988- 78

AUTHORIZING A PERSONAL SERVICES CONTRACT WITH DR. GERALD BARRETT FOR PERSONNEL CONSULTING SERVICES. (NOT TO EXCEED \$75,000 PERSONNEL DEPARTMENT BUDGET).

WHEREAS, the United States District Court, Northern District of Ohio, has decreed that The Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority shall comply with the federal law relating to personnel policies and procedures in the matter of Frederick Crawford vs. The Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Case No. C86-2490; and

WHEREAS, the Authority requires the professional services of Dr. Gerald Barrett for the purpose of assisting in the preparation, implementation and validation of personnel policies and procedures which were agreed to as part of the remedial order; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Gerald Barrett is acceptable to the Court and has agreed to provide such services on a personal service basis for so long as such services are required.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of The Greater Cleveland Rapid Transit Authority, Cuyahoga, County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the General Manager be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a professional services contract with Dr. Gerald Barrett on an hourly fee basis, to perform personnel consulting services for The Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga, County, Ohio commencing on December 2, 1987.

Section 2. That Dr. Gerald Barrett shall be paid a fee of \$100.00 per half hour and any fraction thereof not to exceed \$75,000 for the period ending December 31, 1988, payable out of the General Fund.

Section 3. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
