

RESOLUTION 1988- 82

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH HART GRAPHICS INC.
(SMARTMAPS) FOR PRODUCTION OF A COMPUTER GENERATED
TRANSIT SYSTEM, MAP AND TIMETABLES (PLANNING DEPARTMENT
BUDGET EST. \$57,863 - GENERAL FUND)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 1987-225, adopted October 6, 1987, Competitive Proposals were received on March 18, 1988, for the production of Computer Generated Transit System Maps and Timetables.

WHEREAS, the proposals were properly evaluated in accordance with the criteria set forth in the Request for Proposal using Part 15 of the FAR as guidance; and

WHEREAS, the proposal submitted by Hart Graphics Inc. (Smartmaps) was determined to be the best and most responsive to the needs of the Authority.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Rapid Transit Authority, Cuyahoga, County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the proposal submitted by Hart Graphics Inc. (Smartmaps) be and it is hereby approved as the best and most responsive proposal for the production of a Computer Generated Transit System, Map and Timetables.

Section 2. That the General Manager be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Hart Graphics Inc. (Smartmaps) to provide a computer generated system map and timetables at an estimated cost plus fixed fee of \$57,863.

Section 3. That said contract shall incorporate and be consistent with the proposal of Hart Graphics Inc. (Smartmaps) as modified by negotiation.


Section 4. That said contract shall be payable from the General Fund.

Section 5. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor with the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 6. That said contract is subject to UMTA approval.

Section 7. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
