

RESOLUTION 1988-115

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITHOUT COMPETITIVE BIDDING WITH (WABCO) WESTINGHOUSE AIR BRAKE COMPANY FOR THE FURNISHING OF BRAKE CONTROL PARTS FOR LRV's FOR A PERIOD OF ONE (1) YEAR. (EST. \$400,000.00 - GENERAL FUND)

WHEREAS, certain Brake Control Parts are manufactured only by Westinghouse Air Brake Company, and cannot be secured from any source other than Westinghouse Air Brake Company; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code 306.43(B) provides that competitive bidding is not required for replacement parts of Transit Authority Equipment if the only source is from a single supplier;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That it is hereby determined that these commodities are non-competitive and cannot be secured from any source other than Westinghouse Air Brake Company.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Westinghouse Air Brake Company, for the furnishing of Brake Control Parts for a period of one (1) year, involving an estimated expenditure of Four Hundred Thousand & 00/100 (\$400,000.00) Dollars.

Section 3. That the purchase orders issued by the Department of Procurement shall be in accordance with the Westinghouse Air Brake Company Parts Price List and Terms on file with the Authority.

Section 4. That said contract is subject to UMTA approval.

Section 5. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Specification; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding, insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 6. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
