

RESOLUTION NO. 1988- 140

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH R. J. PLATTEN CONTRACTING COMPANY FOR PROJECT 2.17 - REHABILITATION OF THE BIDDULPH/TIEDEMAN BUS LOOP (\$26,565.00 - GENERAL FUND - CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT & ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT)

WHEREAS, the bid of R. J. Platten Contracting Company for Project 2.17 - Rehabilitation of the Biddulph/Tiedeman Bus Loop was received on the 30th day of June, 1988, for the price set forth in said bid, involving an expenditure of Twenty Six Thousand Five Hundred Sixty-Five (\$26,565.00) Dollars;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of R. J. Platten Contracting Company for Project 2.17 - Rehabilitation of the Biddulph/Tiedeman Bus Loop be and the same is hereby approved as the lowest and best responsive bid from a responsible bidder.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with R. J. Platten Contracting Company.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Fund in an amount of Twenty Six Thousand Five Hundred Sixty-Five (\$26,565.00) Dollars.

Section 4. That said contract is subject to UMTA approval.

Section 5. That said contract shall be binding upon and obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 6. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
