

**A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A POLICY ON THE
PROVISION OF AIR CONDITIONING ON
GREATER CLEVELAND REGIONAL TRANSIT AUTHORITY BUSES**

WHEREAS, the provision of air conditioning on Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority buses would make the buses more comfortable during the hot summer months, and;

WHEREAS, such an increase in comfort would improve the quality of service for current riders and would enhance ridership; and

WHEREAS, such an increase in comfort would improve working conditions for bus operators, and;

WHEREAS, the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority heavy rail and light rail vehicles are air conditioned.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority:

SECTION 1. That all new buses will be purchased with air conditioning.


SECTION 2. That the economic feasibility of retrofitting currently owned buses with air conditioning be fully evaluated and a recommendation be made to the Board of Trustees for inclusion in the 1989 Budget.

SECTION 3. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
