

RESOLUTION NO. 1988- 165

**AUTHORIZING CONTRACTS WITH AMERICAN TRAD-A-BUS,
JOE'S AUTO WRECKING, KINGSWAY CONSTRUCTION COMPANY,
NORTHERN OHIO RAILWAY MUSEUM AND WOOSTER IRON &
METAL FOR THE SALE OF FIFTY-TWO (52) OPERABLE
AND/OR NON-OPERABLE BUSES.**

WHEREAS, Coaches Nos. 100, 101, 102, 103, 104, 105, 109, 115, 122, 131, 134, 144, 153, 155, 156, 157, 161, 173, 184, 198, 199, 846, 882, 885, 892, 894, 3020, 3027, 3028, 3039, 3041, 3048, 3054, 3069, 3077, 3081, 3082, 3084, 3085, 3086, 3087, 3089, 3090, 3091, 3093, 8010, 8011, 8041, 8055, 8067, 8118, 8138 have been determined to be obsolete in accordance with the Authority's bus replacement policy or in accordance with the Board of Trustees' previous Resolution 1986-141 authorizing the sale of American Motors General coaches; and

WHEREAS, the bids of American Trad-A-Bus, Joe's Auto Wrecking, Kingsway Construction Company, Northern Ohio Railway Museum and Wooster Iron & Metal were received on the 2nd day of September, 1988, for the total sale price of Twenty-Eight Thousand Two Hundred Eighty-Eight & 25/100 (\$28,288.25) Dollars;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bids of American Trad-A-Bus, Joe's Auto Wrecking, Kingsway Construction Company, Northern Ohio Railway Museum and Wooster Iron & Metal as listed below be and the same are hereby deemed as the highest responsive bids from responsible bidders:

American Trad-A-Bus for the sale of Coaches Nos. 8010, 8011, 8067, 8118, 8138 for the sale price of Three Thousand Eight Hundred Eighty-Eight & 85/100 (\$3,888.85) Dollars.

Joe's Auto Wrecking for the sale of Coaches Nos. 846, 882, and 885 for the sale price of One Thousand Two Hundred Thirty-Nine & 00/100 (\$1,239.00) Dollars.

Kingsway Construction Company for the sale of Coaches Nos. 892, 3082 and 3090 for the sale price of One Thousand Five Hundred & 00/100 (\$1,500.00) Dollars.

Northern Ohio Railway Museum for the sale of Coach No. 3028 for the sale price of Two Thousand One Hundred & 00/100 (\$2,100.00) Dollars.

Wooster Iron & Metal for the sale of Coaches Nos. 100, 101, 102, 103, 104, 105, 109, 115, 122, 131, 134, 144, 153, 155, 156, 157, 161, 173, 184, 198, 199, 894, 3020, 3027, 3039, 3041, 3048, 3054, 3069, 3077, 3081, 3084, 3085, 3086, 3087, 3089, 3091, 3093, 8041 and 8055 for the sale price of Nineteen Thousand Five Hundred Sixty & 40/100 (\$19,560.40) Dollars.

That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into contracts with the said companies for the sale of said property as described on such terms as are appropriate for the protection of the interests of the Authority:

Section 3. That the proceeds of said sales, Twenty-Eight Thousand Two Hundred Eighty-Eight & 25/100 (\$28,288.25) Dollars be deposited into the General Fund.

Section 4. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
