

RESOLUTION NO. 1988-171

**AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH THE MARBRO CONSTRUCTION CO. FOR PROJECT 1.91A, RED LINE RAPID TRANSIT STATION REPAIRS AT EAST 120TH, EAST 105TH, EAST 79TH, WEST 65TH AND WEST 98TH STREETS (EST. \$479,900.00 - CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND).**

WHEREAS, the bid of Marbro Construction Co. for Project 1.91A, Red Line Rapid Transit Station Repairs at East 120th, East 105th, East 79th, West 65th and West 98th Streets was received on the 2nd day of September, 1988 for the price set forth in said bid, involving an expenditure of Four Hundred Seventy-Nine Thousand Nine Hundred & 00/100 (\$479,900.00) Dollars.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of the Marbro Construction Co. for Project 1.91A, Red Line Rapid Transit Station Repairs be and the same is hereby deemed as the lowest and best responsive bid from a responsible bidder based on the lowest price.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the Marbro Construction Co.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the Capital Improvement Fund in the amount of Four Hundred Seventy Nine Thousand Nine Hundred & 00/100 (\$479,900.00) Dollars.

Section 4. That said contract is subject to UMTA approval.

Section 5. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 6. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
