

RESOLUTION NO. 1988- 181

**AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH WELDON, WILLIAMS & LICK, INC. FOR THE FURNISHING OF FLASH PASSES FOR A PERIOD OF THREE (3) YEARS (EST. \$117,874.56 - GENERAL FUND) REVENUE DEPARTMENT BUDGET.**

WHEREAS, the bid of Weldon, Williams & Lick, Inc. for the furnishing of Flash Passes was received on the 30th day of September, 1988, for the price set forth in said bid, involving an estimated expenditure of One Hundred Seventeen Thousand Eight Hundred Seventy-Four & 56/100 (\$117,874.56) Dollars;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Weldon, Williams & Lick, Inc. for the furnishing of Flash Passes be and the same is hereby deemed as the lowest and best responsive bid from a responsible bidder based on the lowest unit price.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Weldon, Williams & Lick, Inc. for the furnishing of Flash Passes for a period of three (3) years.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the General Fund in an estimated amount not to exceed One Hundred Seventeen Thousand Eight Hundred Seventy-Four & 56/100 (\$117,874.56) Dollars.

Section 4. That said contact is subject to UMTA approval.

Section 5. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 6. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
