RESOLUTION OF COMMENDATION TO MARK STANISA

WHEREAS, on October 28, 1988, Mark Stanisa boarded a Regional Transit Authority vehicle (Block-2802, Coach 8254) eastbound on Euclid Avenue from Windermere; and

WHEREAS, at approximately 4:16 p.m. at Cliffview and Euclid, a male that had been harassing a girl on the bus, threw her off the bus to the ground and began hitting her; and

WHEREAS, Mark Stanisa with a few other passengers, exited the bus to help the female and was consequently hit and then shot; and

WHEREAS, the three suspects fled the scene and Mark was taken to the hospital for his wound.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That Mark Stanisa, by his unselfish, caring actions in coming to the aid of someone in distress, without a thought for his own personal safety, has shown himself to be a credit to the community and is to be highly commended for his courage, and for not being afraid to become involved.

Section 2. That the General Manager/Secretary-Treasurer be and he is hereby instructed to deliver an appropriate memorialization of this Resolution to Mark Stanisa.
