

RESOLUTION NO. 1988 - 190

AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF ROCK SALT FROM THE CITY OF CLEVELAND (EST. \$35,000 - GENERAL FUND). FACILITIES MAINTENANCE BUDGET.

WHEREAS, Rock Salt is necessary to remove snow and ice from various Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority properties during the winter of 1988-89; and

WHEREAS, the City of Cleveland purchases large quantities of Salt through the bid process and in conformity with the Charter of the City of Cleveland, and is permitted to sell quantities of supplies to other political subdivision; and

WHEREAS, the procurement of large quantities achieves for the city economy of scale which can be passed to other political subdivisions;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the General Manager be and he is hereby authorized to negotiate a contract for the purchase of Rock Salt from the City of Cleveland.


Section 2. That said purchase shall be payable out of the General Fund and the expenditure shall not exceed Thirty Five Thousand & 00/100 (\$35,000.00) Dollars.
