

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH CARRIER TRANSICOLD CORPORATION FOR THE RETROFITTING OF 336 BUSES AND 43 MINIBUSES WITH AIR-CONDITIONING (EST. \$2,334,786.00 - CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND) BUS EQUIPMENT DEPARTMENT BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the bid of Carrier Transicold Corporation for the Retrofitting of 336 Buses and 43 Minibuses with Air-conditioning was received on the 24th of January, 1989, for the price set forth in said bid, involving an estimated expenditure of Two Million Three Hundred Thirty-Four Thousand Seven Hundred Eighty-Six & 00/100 (\$2,334,786.00) Dollars;

WHEREAS, the General Manager deems the bid of Carrier Transicold Corporation to be the lowest and best responsive bid from a responsible bidder, and recommends acceptance thereof by the Board of Trustees;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority, Cuyahoga County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the bid of Carrier Transicold Corporation for the Retrofitting of 336 Buses and 43 Minibuses with Air-conditioning be and the same is hereby accepted as the lowest and best responsive bid from a responsible bidder based on the lowest total price.

Section 2. That the General Manager of the Authority be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Carrier Transicold Corporation for the Retrofitting of 336 Buses and 43 Minibuses with air-conditioning.

Section 3. That said contract shall be payable out of the Capital Improvement Fund in an estimated amount not to exceed Two Million Three Hundred Thirty-Four Thousand Seven Hundred Eighty-Six & 00/100 (\$2,334,786.00) Dollars.

Section 4. That said contract shall be binding upon and an obligation of the Authority contingent upon compliance by the contractor to the Bid Specification and Addenda, if any; the Affirmative Action Plan adopted by the Board of Trustees in Resolution 1985-87; bonding and insurance requirements and all applicable laws relating to the contractual obligations of the Authority.

Section 5. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
